

# **Project Details**

Over 500 Stonewood Architectural Panels adorn the Stillaguamish Administration Building in Arlington, WA.

Built by the architectural firm Womer & Associates, the building was designed to resemble a canoe, with various natural textures and indigenous elements utilized throughout the complex. Architects chose Stonewood Panels in a warm woodgrain to complement the hues of the surrounding landscape, as well as the raw materials that accent the building's interior.

The \$13.8 million administration center is built on tribal trust land adjacent to the Stillaguamish Reservation, and will bring together previously scattered departments.
